PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT

This document establishes a transfer articulation agreement between Houghton College (Houghton) and Jamestown Community College (JCC). Its purpose is to afford students the opportunity to pre-plan their college careers, and to facilitate the transfer process from the Associate in Arts (A.A.) in Liberal Arts and Sciences: Social Science degree program at JCC to the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in Psychology degree program at Houghton.

GENERAL GUARANTEE OF ADMISSION AND STANDING

Students who graduate from JCC with the A.A. Liberal Arts and Sciences: Social Science degree are guaranteed acceptance by Houghton and into the B.A. Psychology degree program at Houghton provided they have a minimum JCC cumulative grade point average of 2.75. Students who transfer 60 or more credit hours to Houghton are guaranteed full junior standing. Students who graduate from JCC with any Associate in Arts or Associate in Science degree will have their Houghton Integrative Studies (general education) requirements considered complete except for Biblical Literature and Introduction to Christianity.

GENERAL GUARANTEE OF OPPORTUNITY TO GRADUATE

Students who graduate from JCC with the A.A. Liberal Arts and Sciences: Social Science degree and at least 54 transferable credit hours from among the courses listed in Appendix A of this agreement are guaranteed the opportunity to earn the B.A. Psychology degree with four semesters of normal coursework at Houghton. Transferred coursework must include PSY 1510 at JCC in order to graduate in four semesters from Houghton.

To earn a baccalaureate degree, students must complete a minimum of 60 credit hours at Houghton, complete at least 50 percent of the major requirements at Houghton, and complete a minimum of 124 credit hours (128 for the B. Mus. degree). Houghton will accept in transfer up to 67 credit hours. Houghton requires a minimum grade of C for a course to transfer.
